

## **DNR Services**

If you are registering a small boat, snowmobile, ATV, Off Highway Motorcycle (OHM), or Off Highway Vehicle (OHV) bring your registration number, serial number, make and model when you come to the license area. If you are transferring the vehicle, you will also need to bring an original bill of sale.

Boats that have a loan, are titled in another state, or are newer than 1979 and longer than 16 feet are titled. When titled for the first time or transferring a boat, bring in the appropriate documents such as the Manufacturer's Statement of Origin (MSO), MN or out of state title, lien release and bill of sale.

For snowmobile renewals, you have the option to purchase a three year trail permit for \$31.00. If you ride on any state trails you will need to purchase a trail permit in addition to your registration. A three year permit can only be purchased with registration or at the time of transfer. Otherwise, a one year trail permit can be purchased for \$16.00.

Hunting and fishing licenses can be purchased at our office. Bring in your drivers license when applying for a license. A social security number is required for all hunting and fishing licenses and firearm safety cards.

Children up to age 15 do not need a fishing license. Anyone 16 and older requires an individual fishing license.
