SHOOTING/TRAINING AREA GUIDELINES

Shooting Area Reservation Procedures

- Shooting area may be reserved by NMYHA members. Reservations may be made in person at CAC Customer Service office or by calling 763-493-8333.
- **Non NMYHA members may use shooting area on a first-come first-serve basis.**

Shooting Area Rules/Procedures

- The key for the shooting area is available at the CAC Customer Service office. A driver's license is required to check out the key.
- **Adult supervision is required, either a coach or parent needs to be present with any youth using the shooting area.**
- Please show respect for others while you use the shooting area. Do not harass people on the ice; show them the same respect that you get with your ice time.
- **Do not block the walking track or stick handle on the track. The walking track is heavily used and those users need to be allowed access to the track. If you are waiting to use the shooting area, please wait in the bleacher area or just outside the shooting/training area without blocking the walking track.**
- Only two (2) people can be in the shooting area at one time, this includes a goalie.
- **Shoot at the goal tarp only.**
- Shoes are not to be on the shooting surface. Shoes will leave marks and can ground dirt into the surface.
- **Pick up all pucks and clean up the shooting area when you are done.**
