Sealed proposals will be received at the office of the City Clerk, City Hall, 5200 85th Avenue North, Brooklyn Park, MN 55443, until 11:00 a.m. on March 29, 2010 for CIP 3706-09, Shingle Creek Restoration Phase II (Reach 7A). The work can be generally described as 1500 L.F. of channel restoration between Candlewood Drive and Hampshire Avenue North. **A Pre-Bid meeting is scheduled for 9:00 a.m., March 19, 2010 at the city park located at Hampshire Avenue N. and 80th Avenue N.**

The City Council will consider the bids at 7:00 p.m. on April 5, 2010, in the Council Chambers at the City Hall.

Unless otherwise specifically indicated under the item description of the legal advertisement, all bids shall be subject to the following:

No bids shall be withdrawn for a period of **SIXTY (60)** days after opening of bids. The City reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive informalities.

No bids will be considered unless sealed and filed with the City Clerk of the City of Brooklyn Park and accompanied by a cashier's check, bid bond or certified check payable to the City of Brooklyn Park for five (5%) percent of the amount of the bid, (to be forfeited as liquidated damages in the event that the bid be accepted and the bidder shall fail to enter promptly into a written contract and furnish the required bond).

NOTICE OF BIDS WANTED BY THE CITY CLERK:

Furnish and install the following estimated quantities:

- 3 cross-vanes & 2 J-vanes (rock structures)
- 1,650 SY Geotextile fabric
- Stream bank restoration including: removal of 50 trees, removal of 425 LF timber retaining wall, 4,550 live stakes, 90 SY brush mattress, 60 tons of MnDOT Class III riprap, and 163 tons of boulders
- Three (3) year warranty and maintenance of vegetation.
